MEETING

2. Commonwealth Walkway

- 2.1 MP moves agenda item 2 forward and introduces Jim Walker (Outdoor Trust CEO) and Hugo Vickers (Outdoor Trust Chairman) from the Commonwealth Walkway (CW) project to the group. JW and HV give a presentation to the group to explain the CW project and their aims for their visit to the Falkland Islands. HV explained the CW's objectives, where they have established walkways so far and presented a CW marker. JW stated that it was their intention to install a marker in the Falklands and propose a walkway.
- 2.2 MP asked JW and HV if the target of establishing a walkway in Stanley by the next Commonwealth day (Monday 14th March 2016) was achievable, to which JW and HV agreed and felt that it was a realistic aim.

2.3 MP opened the meeting to members of the media and public to ask JW and HV questions. A question was asked on the cost of creating the walkway, to which JW felt £20,000 would be enough. MBa asked if there were any on-going costs and JW stated that there wouldn't be. CS added that the cost of installing the markers could be a part of the Waterfront development works.

2.4 The members of the group agreed that they are supportive of this initiative

1. Review of previous meeting's Minutes

1.1 There were no issues with the previous minutes. The minutes are published on FIDC's website (www.fidc.co.fk). The actions from the previous meeting were mostly covered in the Agenda and will be discussed during the relevant agenda items during this meeting.

3. Waterfront Walk Update

3.1 MP thanked JH for attending the meeting and asked her to provide background to the project she is working on. JH explained the outdoor exhibition she is planning and detailed how she hoped to use this project as a fund raiser to purchase and install children's play equipment near the Shack on Victory Green. JH raised concerns regarding the three options for a pathway from the west end of Victory Green to the Historic Dockyard. CS explained the rationale behind the options. MP thanked JH for her feedback and it was agreed that CS and SB work with JH to agree the best route.

Action – CS and SB to meet JH to agree pathway route from Victory Green to the Historic Dockyard.

3.2 During the discussion on this agenda item, RS apologised for having to leave the meeting early.

4. Historic Dockyard Update

4.1 MB stated that he has been in contact with the AGs, FIMNT and FC to facilitate the process of negotiating a formal agreement for the land at the Historic Dockyard. MB added that the AGs are waiting for a programme of works before proceeding with the Building Licence and the Lease for the area.
